****376 1/35 Russian T62 Model 1962 Main Battle**

Tank **NEW TOOL!**

The T-62 Russian main battle tank was a further development of the T-55 tank. It's 115mm gun in a new turret was the first smoothbore tank gun in use and was accepted for service in July 1961. The full-scale series production of the T-62 began in July 1962. The T-62 became a standard tank in the Soviet arsenal. The T-62 tanks were later replaced in front-line service by the T-64 and T-72. Kit consists of 492 parts on 17 sprues plus newly tooled lower & upper hulls, photo-etched parts, turned aluminum gun barrel, individual track links, opening and closing engine cover, separate defender, detailed suspension, slide molded one-piece turret, metal tow chain and markings in green camouflage. ****1656 1/72 Tu-22M3 Backfire C Strategic Bomber**

The Tupolev Tu-22M is a supersonic, swing-wing, long-range strategic and maritime strike bomber developed by the Soviet Union. This Tu-22M3 variant, which first flew in 1976 and entered service in 1983, had new NK-25 engines with substantially more power, wedge-shaped intakes similar to the MiG-25, wings with greater maximum sweep, and a recontoured nose housing a new Leninets PN-AD radar and NK-45 nav/attack system, which provides much-improved low-altitude flight. It had a revised tail turret with a single cannon. The Russian Federation used the Tu-22M3 in combat against Chechen forces in 1995, carrying out strikes near Grozny.

Kit consists of 398 parts on 15 sprues plus upper/lower fuselages and nose cone. Markings for Russian Air Force "Red 36" and Ukrainian Air Force "Red 57". Completed kit measures nearly 2 feet long with a wingspan of nearly 19". (Bar code: 9580208016566) (Case pk: 8)



****2281 1/32 English Electric (BAC) Lightning F.2A/F.6 Fighter**

The Lightning was a supersonic fighter, remembered for its great speed and natural metal exterior. It was the only all-British Mach 2 fighter aircraft and was renowned for its capabilities as an interceptor. The F.2A was an upgraded variant of the F.2 single-seat fighter to near F.6 standards with Avion 211R engines. A total of 31 were converted from F.2 fighters featuring a larger ventral tank and arrester hook. The F.6 was an improved longer-range variant of the F.3 single-seat fighter with new wings with better efficiency, subsonic performance, increased fuel storage, overwing fuel tanks, larger ventral fuel tank and carried two Red Top missiles. Kit consists of 192 parts on 13 sprues plus a film instrument panel,

landing gear, metal gear struts and rubber tires. Markings for #19 Sqn RAF 1975 and #5 Sqn RAF 1979. Additional features: separate parts for ventral pack so either the F.2A or F.6 variant can be made and two Red Top missiles with clear nose parts. Completed kit measures over 20" long with a wingspan of over 13". (Bar code: 9580208022819) (Case pk: 6)

****2313 1/35 German 17cm Kanone 18 Heavy Artillery Gun NEW TOOL! SRP \$74.95**

The 17cm Kanone 18 heavy gun proved to be an excellent weapon after the start of the war and in 1942 it replaced the Morser 18 gun on the production line. Captured K18's were used by the Allies on several occasions during 1942 in North Africa and again during 1944 in Europe. Like the 15cm K18, the 17cm gun also had to be broken into two loads for transport. The carriage was designed for high speed travel and has a rotating platform. Kit consists of 401 parts on 13 sprues plus barrel carriage, rubber tires, two metal springs, metal tube, photo-etched parts, newly designed gun breech-mechanism and markings for German Army in field grey camouflage. Additional features: rotating platform, either fire or travel position can be built and can be elevated to different angles. (Bar code: 9580208023137) (Case pk: 24)

****5313 1/350 German Prinz Eugen Cruiser, 1945 NEW TOOL! SRP \$139.95**

The Prinz Eugen was the third and last heavy cruiser commissioned by the Kriegsmarine. She became famous on her first war mission in May 1941, the Bismarck in which the Hood was sunk and the Prince of Wales damaged. In February 1942, the Prinz Eugen together with the battleships Scharnhorst and Gneisenau, successfully passed through the English Channel on her way back to Germany. Shortly afterwards, while en route to Norway she was torpedoed and damaged by a British submarine off Trondheim. In 1944-1945, the Prinz Eugen was used for shore bombardment off the Baltic coast. The ship surrendered to the British at Copenhagen in May 1945, and was handed over to the Americans. In July 1946, she survived two nuclear tests in Bikini Atoll. Towed later to Kwajalein Atoll, the Prinz capsized on December 22, 1946. Kit consists of 595 parts on 16 sprues plus upper and lower hulls, waterline plate, wood pattern deck, clear parts and photo-etched handrails, masts and antennas. Additional features: display stand with engraved name plate, SK.C/34 main gun turrets, L/65 C33 secondary gun turrets, 20.3cm gun barrels with hollow ends, two Ar196A-5 aircraft and bonus kit S-100 Class Schnellboot Torpedo Boat on one sprue. Completed kit measures over 23" long. (Bar code: 9580208053134) (Case pk: 12)



****5760 1/700 USS South Dakota BB57 Battleship, 1945 NEW TOOL! SRP \$39.95**

The USS South Dakota, lead ship of a class of 35,000-ton battleships, was built at Camden, New Jersey. She was commissioned in March 1942. From October 1944 to the end of World War II, she screened carrier task forces during strikes in the Western Pacific that ranged from the South China Sea to Japan. The invasions of Leyte, Luzon, Iwo Jima and Okinawa were among these operations. In March and April 1945, the USS South Dakota joined in bombarding Okinawa. She returned to the United States soon thereafter and was decommissioned in January 1947. Kit consists of 371 parts on 10 sprues plus upper and lower hulls, waterline plate and wood pattern deck. Additional features: display stand with engraved name plate, 45 caliber gun turrets, 38 caliber gun turrets and two SOC3 Seagull Scout seaplanes. Completed kit measures over 11" long.
